Instructions

This test measures your ability to understand and follow complex written information. You must read each passage and answer the statements about the passage. Based on the information in the passage, it is your task to select whether you believe this statement is:

- 'True' (T);
- 'False' (F); or,
- you 'cannot say' (X)

Questions

A national bus company are running a campaign to recruit graduates to work in their head office on a new 'going green' environmental campaign. The Human Resources team are currently visiting Universities nationwide to promote this job opportunity. They aim to recruit 10 graduates to work on this project, which starts at the beginning of the next academic year. They are therefore targeting final year undergraduates for this role. There are several stages to the recruitment process. Firstly graduates who show interest must write a 200 word summary of why they are interested in this role. At the same time they must complete a structured application form and questionnaire. The HR team will then select the most appropriate applicants to put forward to the next stage of the assessment which is completion of some online tests, such as a numerical reasoning test and a situational judgement test. Those who successfully complete the online tests will be invited to an assessment centre, the details of which are yet to be finalised but it is likely to include some group work, a presentation and an interview. Several assessment centres will be held throughout the year across a number of locations. Before starting the role successful applicants will have to attend a two week residential training course at the company's training centre in The Midlands.

4.		X	There is no mention of exactly what online tests graduates will have to sit. There are only examples i.e. '...the next stage of the assessment which is completion of some online tests, such as a numerical reasoning test and a situational judgement test.'
